- 12 | standards set forth in 11 Principles of Effective Character
- 13 | Education, which is a research-based set of criteria used to
- 14 | evaluate the total culture of the school community; and

- 16 organization, Character.org and Oklahoma's state affiliate non-
- 17 profit, OKcharacter.org.
