Every act of the Legislature shall embrace but 19 either one general subject, or one comprehensive subject, which 20 shall be clearly expressed in its title, except general 21 appropriation bills, general revenue bills, and bills adopting a 22 code, digest, or revision of statutes; and no law shall be revived, 23 amended, or the provisions thereof extended or conferred, by 24

3	length: Provided, That if any subject be embraced in any act
