6 A Joint Resolution approving in whole certain subject
7 matter standards adopted by the State Board of
Education; directing distribution; and declaring an
8 emergency.

10 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-103.6a-1 of Title 70 of the
11 Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature shall approve in whole or in
12 part, disapprove in whole or in part or amend in whole or in part
13 subject matter standards adopted by the State Board of Education and
14 submitted to the Speaker of the House of Representatives or a
15 designee and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate or a designee
16 for legislative review; and

17 WHEREAS, on March 19, 2018, the State Board of Education
18 submitted to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the
19 President Pro Tempore of the Senate the adopted Oklahoma Academic
20 Standards for Computer Science.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
22 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

23 SECTION 1. The Oklahoma Academic Standards for Computer Science
24 adopted by the State Board of Education and submitted to the Speaker

1 of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the
2 Senate on March 19, 2018, are hereby approved in whole.

3 SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to
4 distribute copies of this resolution to the Governor and the editor
5 of "The Oklahoma Register".

6 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
