8 An Act relating to the Department of Human Services;
9 requiring certain appropriated funds to be used for
10 certain purposes; providing legislative intent;
11 providing for impact of restoration of funds on
12 remaining months of FY-18 budget; and declaring an
13 emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that
16 the Department of Human Services fully fund in its entirety the
17 Advantage Home and Community-based Waiver Program, Money Follows the
18 Person, Homeward Bound Waiver, In-home Supports, Advantage Waiver,
19 Personal Care and state-funded community residential and vocational
20 services within the Department of Human Services in FY-2018 with all
21 of the state, federal, and other existing financial resources
22 available to the Department, including increasing state funds to
23 make up for the loss of Federal FMAP funds so that total spending in
24 FY-2018 is not reduced based on the initial budgeted resources
available at the beginning of FY-18 taking into account restoration

1 of funds pursuant to actions and enactments occurring as a result of
2 the Extraordinary Sessions of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature and the
3 impact of such funds on the remaining months of the FY-18 budget.
4 It is further the Oklahoma Legislature's intent that services to
5 clients and related provider rates within the Advantage Home and
6 Community-based Waiver Program, Money Follows the Person, Homeward
7 Bound Waiver, In-home Supports, Advantage Waiver, Personal Care and
8 state-funded community residential and vocational services not be
9 reduced below contracted rates in effect at the beginning of FY-18
10 taking into account restoration of funds pursuant to actions and
11 enactments occurring as a result of the Extraordinary Sessions of
12 the 56th Oklahoma Legislature and the impact of such funds on the
13 remaining months of the FY-18 budget.

14 SECTION 2. It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that
15 the Department of Human Services fully fund the Adult Day Services
16 in FY-2018 with all of the state, federal, and other existing
17 financial resources available to the Department of Human Services,
18 including increasing state funds to make up for the loss of Federal
19 FMAP funds so that total spending in FY-2018 is no less than the
20 initial budgeted amount in effect at the beginning of FY-18 taking
21 into account restoration of funds pursuant to actions and enactments
22 occurring as a result of the Extraordinary Sessions of the 56th
23 Oklahoma Legislature and the impact of such funds on the remaining
24 months of the FY-18 budget. It is further the Oklahoma

1 Legislature's intent that services to current Adult Day Services
2 clients and related provider rates to such clients not be reduced
3 below contracted rates in effect at the beginning of FY-18 taking
4 into account restoration of funds pursuant to actions and enactments
5 occurring as a result of the Extraordinary Sessions of the 56th
6 Oklahoma Legislature and the impact of such funds on the remaining
7 months of the FY-18 budget.

8 SECTION 3. It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that
9 the Department of Human Services for FY-2018 set foster care,
10 residential, intensive in-home services, group home care and
11 adoption subsidy rates at the same level in effect at the beginning
12 of FY-18 taking into account restoration of funds pursuant to
13 actions and enactments occurring as a result of the Extraordinary
14 Sessions of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature and the impact of such
15 funds on the remaining months of the FY-18 budget.

16 SECTION 4. It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that
17 the Department of Human Services fund the Senior Nutrition Program
18 within the Aging Services Division in FY-2018 with all of the state,
19 federal, and other existing financial resources available to the
20 Department at or above the amount in effect at the beginning of FY-
21 18 taking into account restoration of funds pursuant to actions and
22 enactments occurring as a result of the Extraordinary Sessions of
23 the 56th Oklahoma Legislature and the impact of such funds on the
24 remaining months of the FY-18 budget.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
