Each school district in this state may offer a remediation 16 course for high school students who score below a nineteen (19) on 17 the American College Testing (ACT) exam or below an equivalent score 18 on the SAT exam. 19 B. Nothing in subsection A of this section shall be construed 20 to require that a teacher providing instruction in the remediation 21 course be certified in any subject matter that is tested on the ACT 22 or SAT exam. 23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
