7 An Act relating to schools; permitting school  
8 districts to offer certain remediation course;  
9 providing for certain construction; providing for  
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-107.1 of Title 70, unless  
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. Each school district in this state may offer a remediation  
16 course for high school students who score below a nineteen (19) on  
17 the American College Testing (ACT) exam or below an equivalent score  
18 on the SAT exam.

19 B. Nothing in subsection A of this section shall be construed  
20 to require that a teacher providing instruction in the remediation  
21 course be certified in any subject matter that is tested on the ACT  
22 or SAT exam.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
