NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.9d of Title 36, unless 15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 16 A. Any health benefit plan issued or renewed on or after 17 November 1, 2017, that provides coverage for prescription eyedrops 18 shall not deny coverage for a refill of a prescription if: 19 1. For a thirty-day supply, the amount of time has passed after 20 which a patient should have used seventy percent (70%) of the dosage 21 units of the drug according to a practitioner's instructions, or 22 twenty-one (21) days from: 23 the original date the prescription was distributed to

1	b. the date the most recent refill was distributed to the
2	insured;
3	2. The prescribing practitioner indicates on the original
4	prescription that additional quantities are needed;
5	3. The refill requested by the insured does not exceed the
6	number of additional quantities needed; and
7	4. The prescription eyedrops prescribed by the practitioner are
8	a covered benefit under the policy or contract to the insured.
9	B. As used in this section, "health benefit plan" means any
10	plan or arrangement as defined in subsection C of Section 6060.4 of
11	Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
12	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
