Said Until the effective date of this act, said 16 district shall have five (5) district judges to be nominated and 17 elected as follows: One candidate to be nominated and elected at 18 large and a legal resident of Okfuskee County; two candidates to be 19 nominated and elected at large and legal residents of Okmulgee 20 County; and two candidates to be nominated and elected at large and 21 legal residents of Creek County, all of whom shall be elected at 22 large. Beginning on the effective date of this act, said district 23 shall have four (4) district judges to be nominated and elected as 24 follows: One candidate to be nominated and elected at large and a
