AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 527, is 1.3 amended to read as follows: 14 Section 527. A. The sheriff, treasurer or assessor in a county 15 shall have the authority to employ a general counsel, either in-16 house as a staff attorney or through an outside law firm, to advise 17 or represent that officer and his or her office in the performance 18 of the official duties of that office. The Board of County 19 Commissioners shall approve all contracts for outside counsel. A 20 general counsel employed pursuant to this section shall be 21 compensated from the funds of the employing county office. 22 B. The sheriff may employ outside counsel pursuant to this 23 section to provide immediate representation to a deputy of the 24 sheriff in a deputy-involved shooting incident; provided, the

1	sheriff shall not continue payment to the counsel if the deputy
2	involved is charged with any crime arising from the incident.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
