13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 231, O.S.L.
14	2017 (63 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 1-1991), is amended to read as
15	follows:
16	Section 1-1991. A. The State Board of Health shall promulgate
17	rules that require all medical and direct care staff of nursing and
18	specialized facilities, adult day care centers, assisted living
19	centers, hospice agencies and home health agencies licensed by the
20	State Department of Health to complete, at a minimum, one (1) hour
21	of in-service training per year in Alzheimer's- and dementia-related
22	care.
23	B. The curricula for the training shall include, but not be
24	limited to, learning ways to decode behavior messages, identifying

4	C. The Board shall also promulgate rules establishing
5	appropriate training requirements for support staff working in the
