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7 An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2011,  
8 Section 4-115.2, as amended by Section 2, Chapter  
9 152, O.S.L. 2016 (26 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 4-  
10 115.2), which relates to address confidentiality of  
11 certain registered voters; expanding scope of certain  
12 class to include immediate family members; defining  
13 term; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 4-115.2, as  
16 amended by Section 2, Chapter 152, O.S.L. 2016 (26 O.S. Supp. 2017,  
17 Section 4-115.2), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 4-115.2 A. The Secretary of the State Election Board  
19 is authorized to promulgate rules to keep confidential the residence  
20 and mailing address, upon application to do so, of individual  
21 registered voters who are members of certain classes. These classes  
22 shall be limited to the judiciary, district attorneys, assistant  
23 district attorneys, Uniformed Services members, law enforcement  
24 personnel and the immediate family of law enforcement personnel,  
correctional officers, persons who are protected by victim's

1 protection orders, the spouses and dependents of the members of such  
2 classes, and persons who are certified by the Secretary of State as  
3 participants in the Address Confidentiality Program established by  
4 Section 60.14 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such address  
5 information shall be provided to a candidate or candidate  
6 representative or other lawful authority in anticipation or as part  
7 of a contest of candidacy or contest of an election as provided for  
8 in ~~Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title or as part of a  
9 petition challenge as provided by law. However, no information  
10 concerning the address of a certified Address Confidentiality  
11 Program participant shall be released by election officials to any  
12 person for any purpose except under court order.

13 B. As used in this section, "immediate family of law  
14 enforcement personnel" means a spouse, child by birth or adoption,  
15 stepchild or parent living at the same residence as the law  
16 enforcement personnel.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
