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7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.  
8 2011, Section 802, which relates to commercial driver  
9 training; allowing content related to human  
10 trafficking be included in course of study; requiring  
11 regular review and updating of content; requiring  
12 certain collaboration; requiring certain publication  
in certain manner; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 802, is  
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 802. ~~(A)~~ A. The Commissioner shall adopt and prescribe  
17 such regulations concerning the administration and enforcement of  
18 this act as are necessary to carry out the intent of this act and to  
19 protect the public. The Commissioner or his authorized  
20 representative shall inspect the school facilities and equipment of  
21 applicants and licensees and examine applicants for instructor's  
22 licenses.

23 ~~(B)~~ B. The Commissioner shall administer and enforce the  
24 provisions of this act, and may call upon the State Superintendent

1 of Public Instruction for assistance in developing and formulating  
2 appropriate regulations.

3 C. 1. The Commissioner may require that the course of study  
4 for training students for Class A, B or C commercial licenses  
5 include training on the recognition, prevention and reporting of  
6 human trafficking. If required, the Commissioner shall regularly  
7 review and update the training to take into account changes and  
8 trends in human trafficking. To establish the content of training,  
9 the Commissioner shall collaborate with:

10 a. organizations that specialize in the recognition and  
11 prevention of human trafficking, and

12 b. the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous  
13 Drugs Control.

14 2. The Commissioner shall publish content on the recognition,  
15 prevention and effective reporting of human trafficking in a manner  
16 that is likely to be read by holders of or people training to obtain  
17 a Class A, B or C commercial license.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
