7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.  
8 2011, Section 1135.3, as last amended by Section 2,  
9 Chapter 331, O.S.L. 2017 and 1135.5, as last amended  
10 by Section 1, Chapter 339, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp.  
11 2017, Sections 1135.3 and 1135.5), which relate to  
12 special license plates; modifying lists of special  
13 license plates; transferring authorization for  
14 certain license plate; creating the Techlahoma  
15 Foundation License Plate; establishing the plate as a  
16 financial assistance license plate; providing for  
17 design; authorizing plate personalization;  
18 authorizing certain licensing agreement; limiting  
19 certain payment amounts; and providing an effective  
20 date.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as  
23 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 331, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp.  
24 2017, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby  
authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license  
plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or  
membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other  
subject as provided by this section.

1 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other  
2 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of  
3 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used  
4 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been  
5 registered for the current year.

6 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax  
7 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall  
8 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.  
9 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain  
10 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor  
11 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be  
12 issued on a staggered system.

13 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a  
14 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept  
15 applications for special license plates authorized under this  
16 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's  
17 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount  
18 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary  
19 information directly into such system and generate a receipt  
20 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents  
21 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for  
22 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for  
23 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the  
24 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

1 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates  
2 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,  
3 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of  
4 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special  
5 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license  
6 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration  
7 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be  
8 removed from the vehicle.

9 Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special  
10 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special  
11 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission  
12 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications  
13 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax  
14 Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective  
15 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null  
16 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are  
17 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time  
18 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

19 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as  
20 follows:

21 1. Round and Square Dance License Plate - such plates shall be  
22 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
23 round and square dancing;

1        2. National Association for the Advancement of Colored People  
2 License Plate - such plates shall be designed, subject to the  
3 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the NAACP, and  
4 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

5        3. National Rifle Association License Plate - such plates shall  
6 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax  
7 Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any  
8 person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle  
9 Association;

10       4. Masonic Fraternity License Plate - such plates shall be  
11 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of  
12 a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a  
13 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated  
14 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic  
15 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for  
16 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the  
17 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in  
18 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall  
19 contain the Masonic emblem;

20       5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License  
21 Plate - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for  
22 Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be  
23 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's  
24 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in

1 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall  
2 contain the Shriner's emblem;

3 6. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed  
4 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air  
5 ballooning in this state;

6 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plate - such plates shall  
7 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member  
8 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an  
9 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a  
10 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an  
11 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an  
12 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate  
13 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate  
14 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star  
15 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

16 8. Knights of Columbus License Plate - such plates shall be  
17 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of  
18 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of  
19 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
20 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus  
21 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights  
22 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the  
23 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation  
24

1 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of  
2 Columbus emblem;

3 9. Jaycees License Plate - such plates shall be designed and  
4 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license  
5 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license  
6 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

7 10. Kiwanis International License Plate - such plates shall be  
8 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons  
9 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in  
10 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in  
11 consultation with Kiwanis International;

12 11. Certified Public Accountants License Plate - such plates  
13 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a  
14 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified  
15 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated  
16 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a  
17 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed  
18 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public  
19 Accountants;

20 12. Civil Emergency Management License Plate - such plates  
21 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate  
22 support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons  
23 applying for such license plate must show proof of official  
24 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment,

1 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or  
2 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state  
3 emergency management department head;

4 13. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plate - such plates  
5 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax  
6 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and  
7 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian  
8 Conservation Corps;

9 14. Rotarian License Plate - such plates shall be designed and  
10 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian  
11 Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license  
12 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton  
13 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the  
14 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate  
15 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license  
16 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian  
17 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

18 15. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks License Plate - such  
19 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the  
20 Tax Commission, by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and  
21 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of the  
22 Benevolent Protective Order of Elks;

23 16. Humane Society License Plate - such plates shall be  
24 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for

1 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued  
2 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to  
3 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate  
4 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

5 17. Oklahoma Mustang Club License Plate - such plates shall be  
6 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,  
7 by the Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this  
8 state who is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons  
9 may apply for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon  
10 presentment of proof of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club.  
11 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of  
12 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for  
13 personalized license plates;

14 18. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plate - such  
15 plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business  
16 Clubs. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of  
17 membership in AMBUCS. The license plates shall be designed in  
18 consultation with American Business Clubs;

19 19. West Point 200th Anniversary License Plate - such plates  
20 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate  
21 the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the United States  
22 Military Academy at West Point, New York. The license plates shall  
23 be designed in consultation with the West Point Society of Central  
24 Oklahoma;



1        20. Oklahoma Aquarium License Plate - such plates shall be  
2 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
3 the Oklahoma Aquarium. The license plates shall be designed in  
4 consultation with the Oklahoma Aquarium;

5        21. The Pride of Broken Arrow License Plate - such plates shall  
6 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support  
7 for The Pride of Broken Arrow marching band. The plates shall be  
8 designed in consultation with the Broken Arrow Public School System;

9        22. Fellowship of Christian Athletes License Plate - such  
10 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Fellowship of  
11 Christian Athletes and issued to members and supporters of the  
12 Fellowship of Christian Athletes;

13       23. Parrothead Club License Plate - such plates shall be  
14 designed and issued to members and supporters of the Parrothead  
15 Club. The license plate shall be issued to any person in any  
16 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven as  
17 for personalized license plates;

18       24. Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition License Plate - such plates  
19 shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of the  
20 Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition. The license plates shall be designed  
21 in consultation with the Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition;

22       25. Electric Lineman License Plate - such plates shall be  
23 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
24 Oklahoma's electric linemen. The license plates shall be designed

1 in consultation with the Oklahoma Electric Superintendent's  
2 Association;

3 26. Alpha Kappa Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be  
4 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Kappa  
5 Alpha Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in  
6 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha  
7 Sorority;

8 27. The National Pan-Hellenic Council Incorporated License  
9 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person  
10 wishing to demonstrate support to any of the nine sororities and  
11 fraternities recognized by the National Pan-Hellenic Council  
12 Incorporated. The license plates shall be designed in consultation  
13 with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Pan-Hellenic Council  
14 Incorporated;

15 28. Organ, Eye and Tissue License Plate - such plates shall be  
16 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support and  
17 increase awareness for organ, eye and tissue donation. The license  
18 plates shall be designed in consultation with the State Department  
19 of Health;

20 29. Central Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity License Plate - such  
21 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to  
22 demonstrate support and increase awareness for Habitat for Humanity.  
23 The license plate shall be designed in consultation with Central  
24 Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity;

1        30. Family Career and Community Leaders of America Incorporated  
2 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons  
3 wishing to demonstrate support for Family Career and Community  
4 Leaders of America Incorporated. The license plates shall be  
5 designed in consultation with Family Career and Community Leaders of  
6 America Incorporated;

7        31. Delta Sigma Theta License Plate - such plates shall be  
8 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Delta Sigma  
9 Theta Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in  
10 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority  
11 Incorporated;

12        32. Omega Psi Phi License Plate - such plates shall be designed  
13 and issued to any person who is a member of Omega Psi Phi  
14 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation  
15 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity Incorporated;

16        33. Alpha Phi Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be  
17 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Phi Alpha  
18 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation  
19 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity  
20 Incorporated;

21        34. 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System of Highways  
22 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons  
23 wishing to commemorate the 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System  
24 of Highways. The license plates shall be designed in consultation

1 with the American Association of State Highway and Transportation  
2 Officials;

3 35. Kappa Alpha Psi License Plate - such plates shall be  
4 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Kappa Alpha Psi  
5 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation  
6 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity  
7 Incorporated;

8 36. Sigma Gamma Rho License Plate - such plates shall be  
9 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Sigma Gamma Rho  
10 Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with  
11 the Oklahoma Chapter of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority Incorporated.  
12 Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Sigma  
13 Gamma Rho License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1,  
14 2013;

15 37. Multiple Sclerosis License Plate - such plates shall be  
16 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
17 and increase awareness of multiple sclerosis. The license plates  
18 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the  
19 National Multiple Sclerosis Society;

20 38. Frederick Douglass High School License Plate - such plates  
21 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
22 support for Frederick Douglass High School located in Oklahoma City.  
23 The plates shall be designed in consultation with representatives of  
24 Frederick Douglass High School National Alumni Association;

1        39. United States Air Force Academy License Plate - such plates  
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
3 support for the United States Air Force Academy;

4        40. In God We Trust License Plate - such plates shall be  
5 designed to include the motto, "In God We Trust", and shall be  
6 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the motto;

7        41. National Weather Center License Plate - such plates shall  
8 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support  
9 for the National Weather Center in Norman. The plates shall be  
10 designed in consultation with representatives of the National  
11 Weather Center Directors;

12       42. Make-A-Wish Foundation License Plate - such plates shall be  
13 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
14 the Make-A-Wish Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in  
15 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Make-A-Wish  
16 Foundation;

17       43. South Central Section PGA Foundation License Plate - such  
18 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to

18 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support

22 of subsection A of this section, the Star Spencer High School  
23 License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015;

1        49. Northeast High School License Plate - such plates shall be  
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
3 Northeast High School located in Oklahoma City. The plates shall be  
4 designed in consultation with representatives of the Northeast High  
5 School Alumni Association;

6        50. Oklahoma City Central High School License Plate - such  
7 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
8 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni  
9 Association. The plates shall be designed in consultation with  
10 representatives of the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni  
11 Association;

12       51. Historic Greenwood District License Plate - such plates  
13 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for music  
14 festivals held in the Historic Greenwood District in Tulsa,  
15 Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with

17       52. Oklahoma Rifle Association License Plate - such plates

4 be designed and issued to any person wishing to increase awareness

7 55. BMW Car Club of America License Plate - such plates shall  
8 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support  
9 for the BMW Car Club of America. The plates shall be issued to any  
10 person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a  
11 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license  
12 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Sunbelt Chapter of  
13 the BMW Car Club of America. Subject to the provisions of  
14 subsection A of this section, the BMW Car Club of America License  
15 Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2013;

16 56. Don't Tread On Me License Plate - such plates shall be  
17 designed to include the yellow background and rattlesnake emblem  
18 above the motto "DON'T TREAD ON ME" as found on the historic Gadsden  
19 flag, and shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
20 support for the freedom and liberty of the Republic;

21 57. Oklahomans for the Arts License Plate - such plates shall  
22 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support  
23 for arts, culture and creative industries as well as arts education.  
24



1 The plates shall be designed in consultation with Oklahomans for the  
2 Arts;

3 58. Oklahoma City Barons License Plate - such plates shall be  
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
5 the Oklahoma City Barons. The license plate shall be designed in  
6 consultation with the Oklahoma City Barons organization. The  
7 license plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of  
8 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six;

9 59. Oklahoma City Redhawks License Plate - such plates shall be  
10 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
11 the Oklahoma City Redhawks. The license plate shall be designed in  
12 consultation with the Oklahoma City Redhawks organization;

13 60. Tulsa Shock License Plate - such plates shall be designed  
14 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the  
15 Tulsa Shock. The license plate shall be designed in consultation  
16 with the Tulsa Shock organization;

17 61. Tulsa Oilers License Plate - such plates shall be designed  
18 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the  
19 Tulsa Oilers. The license plate shall be designed in consultation  
20 with the Tulsa Oilers organization;

21 62. Tulsa Drillers License Plate - such plates shall be  
22 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
23 the Tulsa Drillers. The license plate shall be designed in

1        63. Millwood School District License Plate - such plates shall  
2 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support  
3 for the Millwood School District. The license plate shall be  
4 designed in consultation with representatives of the Millwood School  
5 District;

6        64. Booker T. Washington High School License Plate - such  
7 plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
8 Booker T. Washington High School and shall be designed in  
9 consultation with the Booker T. Washington High School National  
10 Alumni Association;

11       65. Oklahoma Current State Flag License Plate - such plates  
12 shall be designed to include the current Oklahoma state flag and  
13 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the current  
14 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation  
15 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center;

16       66. Oklahoma Original State Flag License Plate - such plates  
17 shall be designed to include the original Oklahoma state flag and  
18 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the original

12 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for 911 dispatchers.  
13 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of current

1        72. Southeast Spartans Plate - such plates shall be designed  
2        and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
3        Southeast Spartans High School and such plates shall be designed in  
4        consultation with the Southeast High School Alumni Association.

5        C. The fee for such plates shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)  
6        and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by  
7        the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Unless otherwise  
8        provided in this section, the fee shall be apportioned as follows:  
9        Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special license plate fee shall be  
10       deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be  
11       used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and  
12       Registration Act and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the  
13       special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in  
14       Section 1104 of this title.

15       SECTION 2.        AMENDATORY        47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as  
16       last amended by Section 1, Chapter 339, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp.  
17       2017, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

18       Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby  
19       authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license  
20       plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide  
21       financial assistance as provided by this section.

22       Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other  
23       person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of  
24       ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used

1 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been  
2 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

3 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax  
4 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall  
5 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.  
6 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain  
7 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor  
8 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be  
9 issued on a staggered system.

10 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a  
11 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept  
12 applications for special license plates authorized under this  
13 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's  
14 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount  
15 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary  
16 information directly into such system and generate a receipt  
17 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents  
18 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for  
19 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for  
20 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the  
21 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

22 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates  
23 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,  
24 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of

1 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special  
2 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license  
3 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration  
4 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be  
5 removed from the vehicle.

6 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,  
7 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax  
8 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid  
9 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by  
10 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the  
11 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall  
12 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are  
13 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time  
14 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

15 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as  
16 follows:

17 1. University or College Supporter License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such  
18 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
19 demonstrate support to any state-supported or private university or  
20 college. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee  
21 collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this  
22 title;

23 2. Environmental Awareness License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates  
24 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the

1 Tax Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in  
2 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any  
3 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide  
4 general public environmental education program created pursuant to  
5 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such  
6 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination  
7 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for  
8 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued  
9 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated  
10 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee  
11 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by  
12 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in  
13 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned  
14 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

15 3. Firefighter License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be  
16 designed for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.  
17 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four  
18 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a  
19 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an  
20 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.  
21 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of  
22 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to  
23 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any  
24 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may

1 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated  
2 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon  
3 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire  
4 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief  
5 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in  
6 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

7 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
8 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &  
9 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma State Firefighters Museum  
10 and the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

11 4. Wildlife Conservation License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates  
12 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the  
13 Tax Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation  
14 in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any  
15 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in  
16 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in  
17 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may  
18 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license  
19 plates.

20 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
21 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of  
22 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

23 5. Child Abuse Prevention License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates  
24 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the



1 Tax Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State  
2 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child  
3 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
4 the prevention of child abuse.

5 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
6 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

7 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License ~~Plates~~  
8 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person  
9 wishing to demonstrate support for the United States Olympic  
10 Committee. The plates shall be issued to any person in any  
11 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,  
12 as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the  
13 official United States Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission  
14 shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a licensing  
15 agreement with the United States Olympic Committee for any licensing  
16 fees which may be required in order to use the United States Olympic  
17 Committee logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for  
18 a payment of not more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each  
19 license plate issued;

20 7. Oklahoma History License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be  
21 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in  
22 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee  
23 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society  
24 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

1        8. Historic Route 66 License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall  
2 be designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother  
3 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
4 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving  
5 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,  
6 Oklahoma;

7        9. Heart of the Heartland License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates  
8 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the  
9 victims of the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah  
10 Federal Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As  
11 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be  
12 deposited in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as  
13 established in Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

14       10. Emergency Medical Technician License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such  
15 plates shall be designed and issued to any person who is an  
16 emergency medical technician. Such persons may apply for an  
17 emergency medical technician license plate for each vehicle with a  
18 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an  
19 emergency medical technician's license. The license plate shall be  
20 designed in consultation with the state association of emergency  
21 medical technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the  
22 fee collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical  
23 Personnel Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2  
24 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1        11. Fight Breast Cancer License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates  
2 shall be designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and  
3 treatment of breast cancer in this state. As provided in this  
4 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the  
5 Breast Cancer Act Revolving Fund;

6        12. Crime Victims Awareness License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates  
7 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
8 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates  
9 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims  
10 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
11 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for  
12 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use  
13 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to  
14 provide services to crime victims;

15        13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such  
16 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
17 demonstrate support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids  
18 Association. The license plate shall be designed in consultation  
19 with the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. As provided in this  
20 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the  
21 Children's Hospital - Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund  
22 to be distributed to the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

23        14. Four-H Club License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be  
24 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission

1 by the Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to  
2 demonstrate support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed  
3 and issued to any person as for personalized license plates. As  
4 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be  
5 apportioned to the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving  
6 Fund created in Section 1104.4 of this title;

7 15. Agricultural Awareness License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates  
8 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax  
9 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and  
10 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued  
11 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag  
12 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an  
13 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in  
14 Section 1104.3 of this title;

15 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such  
16 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
17 commemorate the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in  
18 1907. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the  
19 Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission.  
20 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be  
21 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial  
22 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of  
23 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1        17. Support Education License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall  
2 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax  
3 Commission by the State Department of Education in consultation with  
4 the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to  
5 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license  
6 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education ~~License~~  
7 license plate in the area of the business accessed by the public.  
8 Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be  
9 apportioned as follows:

- 10            a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education  
11                Reform Revolving Fund,
- 12            b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher  
13                Education Revolving Fund,
- 14            c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State

20 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
21 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall  
22 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters  
23 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.  
24 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.

1 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into  
2 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any  
3 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts  
4 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide  
5 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty  
6 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

7 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License ~~Plates~~ Plate -  
8 such plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented  
9 to the Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture,  
10 Food, and Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in  
11 this state that develop and operate programs to encourage urban  
12 forestry and beautification, and issued to any person wishing to  
13 demonstrate support of such programs. As provided in this section,  
14 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in  
15 Section 1104.5 of this title;

16 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such  
17 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the  
18 Tax Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department,  
19 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the  
20 Oklahoma state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the  
21 fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and  
22 Recreation Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be  
23 designated for and may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma  
24 state parks;

1        22. Adoption Creates Families License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such  
2 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support  
3 of pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for  
4 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive  
5 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and  
6 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates  
7 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation  
8 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human  
9 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall  
10 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury  
11 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the  
12 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act  
13 specifically for created families;

14        23. Choose Life License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be  
15 designed, subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by  
16 Choose Life, Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to

19 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited  
20 in the Choose Life Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in  
21 Section 1104.6 of this title;

22        24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall  
23 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
24 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The



1 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma  
2 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an  
3 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in  
4 Section 1104.7 of this title;

5 25. Lions Club License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be  
6 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
7 the Lions Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any  
8 person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a  
9 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license  
10 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions  
11 Service Foundation and shall contain the official logo of the  
12 International Association of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall  
13 be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma  
14 Lions Service Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for  
15 a payment to the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than

1        27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter  
2 License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to  
3 any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the  
4 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person  
5 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of  
6 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain  
7 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The  
8 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a  
9 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of  
10 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use  
11 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The  
12 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts  
13 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout  
14 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license

16        28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such  
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to

19 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City  
20 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter  
21 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon  
22 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the  
23 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing  
24 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial

1 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license  
2 plate issued;

3 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be  
4 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The  
5 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic  
6 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be  
7 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

8 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed  
9 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.  
10 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The  
11 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the  
12 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be  
13 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty  
14 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma  
15 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

16 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be  
17 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
18 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational  
19 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in  
20 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty  
21 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the  
22 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet  
23 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the

1 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in  
2 Section 1104.10 of this title;

3 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in  
4 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to  
5 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who  
6 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active  
7 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination  
8 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for  
9 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion  
10 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate  
11 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

12 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be  
13 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma  
14 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma  
15 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States  
16 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on  
17 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any  
18 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As  
19 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be  
20 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in  
21 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

22 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License ~~Plates~~  
23 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person  
24 wishing to demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of

1 America. The plates shall be issued to any person in any  
2 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,  
3 as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the  
4 official Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission,  
5 if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with the Boys and  
6 Girls Clubs of America for any licensing fees which may be required  
7 in order to use the Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design.

16 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving  
17 Fund created in Section 1104.12 of this title;

18 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
