Each person training as an apprentice shall 19 be required to have the same qualifications as a student for 20 admission into a cosmetology or barber school, and shall be 21 registered with the State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering before 22 commencing the training. 23 B. No apprentice shall engage in any of the practices of 24 cosmetology or barbering except under the immediate supervision of a

2	approved by the Board for apprentice training.
3	C. All apprentices must wear a badge which designates them as
4	an apprentice and is furnished by the Board with the apprentice
5	registration receipt.

9	E. Completion of three thousand (3,000) two thousand (2,000)
