8 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
9 amending 59 O.S. 2011, Section 199.8, as last amended
10 by Section 6, Chapter 260, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp.
11 2017, Section 199.8), which relates to the Oklahoma
12 Cosmetology and Barbering Act; modifying number of
13 apprentices registered to receive training; reducing
14 hours of training needed for examination; and
15 providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 199.8, as
18 last amended by Section 6, Chapter 260, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp.
19 2017, Section 199.8), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 199.8 A. Each person training as an apprentice shall
21 be required to have the same qualifications as a student for
22 admission into a cosmetology or barber school, and shall be
23 registered with the State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering before
24 commencing the training.

B. No apprentice shall engage in any of the practices of
cosmetology or barbering except under the immediate supervision of a

1 licensed instructor in a cosmetology or barber establishment
2 approved by the Board for apprentice training.

3 C. All apprentices must wear a badge which designates them as
4 an apprentice and is furnished by the Board with the apprentice
5 registration receipt.

6 D. ~~Only one apprentice~~ No more than two apprentices may be
7 registered to receive training in any cosmetology or barber
8 establishment at any one time.

9 E. Completion of ~~three thousand (3,000)~~ two thousand (2,000)
10 hours of apprentice training in a cosmetology or barber
11 establishment is the equivalent of one thousand five hundred (1,500)
12 hours' training in a cosmetology or barber school and shall entitle
13 the apprentice to take the examination.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
