14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2001 of Title 82, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. Effective January 15, 2019, each municipality within the
18	state shall implement an inclined block rate structure for use of
19	municipal water by persons, business entities and other users. The
20	municipality may retain all revenues derived from the sale of water
21	to each user

B. Municipalities that implement an inclined block rate

structure may, in its discretion, impose surcharges for a municipal

water user that uses more than twenty-five thousand (25,000) gallons

Τ	of water per month, water use surcharge revenues may be used by the
2	municipality or an entity having the municipality as its beneficiary
3	for municipal water systems and related infrastructure assets.
4	C. The provisions of this section shall not be applicable to
5	water sold to (1) any city, town, rural water district or nonprofit
6	corporations that are engaged in the sale or resale of water; (2)
7	water sold to customers of a municipality that have a history of
8	treated water usage over the prior twelve (12) months of at least
9	five hundred thousand (500,000) gallons per month (excluding
10	irrigation water) and with a peak to average monthly treated water
11	use ratio of 1.25 or less; and (3) municipal treated wastewater
12	reuse sales.
13	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 15, 2019.
