8 An Act relating to tourism; creating the Oklahoma
9 Tourism and Recreation Department Reimbursement and
10 Donation Fund; providing for expenditure of funds;
11 prohibiting certain transfer of funds; providing for
12 codification; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2254.2 of Title 74, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
18 fund for the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, to be
19 designated the "Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department
20 Reimbursement and Donation Fund". The fund shall be a continuing
21 fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of
22 donations, insurance reimbursements, Federal Emergency Management
23 Agency (FEMA) payments, and other reimbursement monies received by
24 the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department.

B. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department.

C. No monies from this revolving fund shall be transferred for any purpose to any other state agency. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
