20 song for the State of Oklahoma; repealing 25 O.S.  
21 2011, Section 155, which prohibits printing or  
22 lettering on the flags of the United States of  
23 America; providing for codification; and providing an

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 94.14 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The official inspirational song of the State of Oklahoma is hereby declared to be "I Can Only Imagine" by Mercy Me.

SECTION 2. REPEALER 25 O.S. 2011, Section 155, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
