AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1253, as 14 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 95, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp. 15 2017, Section 1253), is amended to read as follows: 16 Section 1253. A. There is hereby re-created, to continue until 17 July 1, 2018 2024, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma 18 Sunset Law, the State Board of Licensed Social Workers, consisting 19 of seven (7) members. 20 Three of the members of the Board shall be licensed social 21 workers or licensed clinical social workers licensed pursuant to the 22 provisions of the Social Worker's Licensing Act. Two other members 23 shall be licensed as either social work associates or master's 24 social workers. One member shall be the president of the Oklahoma

- Chapter of the National Association of Social Workers. The remaining member of the Board shall be selected from and shall represent the general public.
 - C. Responsibility for enforcement of the provisions of the Social Worker's Licensing Act is hereby vested in the State Board of Social Work. The Board shall have all of the duties, powers and authority specifically granted by, or necessary for, the enforcement of the Social Worker's Licensing Act as well as other duties, powers and authority it may be granted by applicable law.
 - D. 1. Each member of the Board appointed as a social worker shall:
 - a. be a resident of this state,
 - b. be licensed in good standing to engage in the practice of social work in this state,
 - c. at the time of appointment, have been actively engaged in the practice of social work for at least one (1) year out of the last five (5) years, and
 - d. have at least three (3) years of experience in the practice of social work.
 - 2. Each member of the Board appointed to represent the general public shall be a resident of this state who has attained the age of majority and shall not be, nor shall ever have been, a social work licensee, or the spouse of a social work licensee, or a person who has ever had any material financial interest in the provision of
