The provisions of this subsection shall only apply 20 to awarded funds when a student withdraws after the second 21 instructional week and before the end of the eighth instructional 22 week of the semester. If a student withdraws after the end of the 23 eighth instructional week of the semester, the awarded funds shall 24 remain with the institution of higher education.
