1 ENGROSSED HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1014 By: Munson and Lepak of the House 3 and 4 Yen of the Senate 5 6 7 A Concurrent Resolution increasing awareness of 8 Alzheimer's disease and other dementias; urging the 9 State Department of Health to designate Alzheimer's disease and other dementias as a public health issue; 10 and providing for distribution. 11 12 13 WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature to 14 increase awareness of Alzheimer's disease and other dementias, 15 address cognitive impairment, promote brain health, and meet the 16 needs of caregivers; and 17 WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease, which currently has no cure, is 18 the sixth leading cause of death in adults age eighteen or older in 19 the United States; and 20 WHEREAS, with no known way to slow or prevent Alzheimer's 21 disease, essential public health services of early detection, risk 22 reduction, and surveillance are necessary to protect and improve the 23 health at a population level; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the State of Oklahoma annually conducts the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) survey to gather statewide public health data; and

WHEREAS, in the 2015 BRFSS survey, 13.6 percent - one in seven - Oklahomans age 45 and older reported an increase in confusion or worsening memory loss and over half of them (55.7 percent) had not discussed these cognitive concerns with a health care provider; and

WHEREAS, caregiving for individuals with Alzheimer's disease often takes an enormous toll on family members; caregivers themselves often suffer more stress, depression, and health problems than caregivers of people with other illnesses; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Legislature recognizes the important role the State Department of Health plays in promoting and encouraging healthy behaviors among the general public, increasing early detection and diagnosis of disease and disability, reducing risk of future injury and illness, educating the health care workforce, and monitoring the health of the state.
