An Act relating to memorial highway designations;
designating the LCPL Trevor A. Roberts Memorial
Highway; designating the Representative David
Brumbaugh Memorial Bridge; requiring certain markers;
providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

SUBJECT: Memorial highway designations

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.250 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The section of Interstate 44 from Southwest 119th Street
extending south to Southwest 149th Street within the municipal
limits of Oklahoma City shall be designated as the "LCPL Trevor A.
Roberts Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
the highway.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.251 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other section of statute and due to the
untimely and sudden passing of State Representative David Brumbaugh,
a proud and dedicated leader for House District 76 and a
distinguished and decorated veteran of the United States Army who is
worthy of such recognition, the bridge over North Aspen Avenue on

the Broken Arrow Expressway shall be designated as the "Representative David Brumbaugh Memorial Bridge" as soon as practical after the effective date of this legislation. The Department of Transportation is hereby directed to cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
