An Act relating to veterans; amending 72 O.S. 2011, Section 2, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 213, O.S.L. 2014 (72 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 2), which relates to definition; modifying definition; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Veterans

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 72 O.S. 2011, Section 2, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 213, O.S.L. 2014 (72 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 2), is amended to read as follows:
- Section 2. The words "ex-service person", "veteran", or "war veteran" used in this act shall be construed to mean such honorably discharged persons as served in any branch of the uniformed services of the United States any person who:
- 1. Has served the full obligation for active duty, Reserve or National Guard service in the military, or received an early discharge for a medical condition, hardship or reduction in force; and
- $\underline{\text{2.}}$ Has been separated or discharged from such service honorably or under honorable conditions.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
