An Act relating to roads and bridges; amending Section 9, Chapter 239, O.S.L. 2016 (69 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 1698.241), which relates to the MSG Joshua Wheeler, U.S. Army Delta Force, Memorial Highway; modifying memorial highway name; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Memorial highway

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 9, Chapter 239, O.S.L. 2016 (69 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 1698.241), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1698.241 The portion of U.S. Highway 64 beginning at the junction of U.S. Highway 64 and State Highway 64B in Sequoyah County extending east to the junction of U.S. Highway 64 and County Road N4760 in Sequoyah County shall be designated as the "MSG Joshua Wheeler, U.S. Army ~~Delta Force~~, Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
