FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to state employee compensation;
providing for salary increase for certain employees;
specifying amount of salary increase; defining terms;
providing salary increase to be provided to certain
employee categories; providing for exclusion of
certain employee categories; providing for contingent
effect; providing for noncodification; providing an
effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

A. Effective July 1, 2018, all full-time and part-time officers
and employees, including temporary and other limited-term employees,
of the state who were employed by the state on the last working day

1 of June 2018 shall be awarded an annualized salary increase equal
2 to:

3 1. Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for persons whose gross
4 annual salary as of June 30, 2018, was Forty Thousand Dollars
5 (\$40,000.00) or less;

6 2. One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for persons
7 whose gross annual salary as of June 30, 2018, was greater than
8 Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00), but less than Fifty Thousand
9 Dollars (\$50,000.00);

10 3. One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for persons whose gross
11 annual salary as of June 30, 2018, was Fifty Thousand Dollars
12 (\$50,000.00) or greater, but less than Sixty Thousand Dollars
13 (\$60,000.00); and

14 4. Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) for persons whose
15 gross annual salary as of June 30, 2018, was Sixty Thousand Dollars
16 (\$60,000.00) or greater.

17 B. As used in this section, "temporary and other limited-term
18 employees" are those persons who:

19 1. Are not full-time or permanent employees;

20 2. Are not otherwise excluded by this section; and

21 3. Are compensated by an agency, board, commission or
22 department or other employing entity for a limited duration and
23 without any subjective expectation by either the employer or the
24 employee that the employment will become permanent.

1 C. Except for those personnel specifically excluded from
2 eligibility for any increase or advancement in salary pursuant to
3 this section, the salary increase provided by this section shall be
4 applicable to:

- 5 1. Employees of county health departments;
- 6 2. Employees of a conservation district; and
- 7 3. Employees of the George Nigh Rehabilitation Institute.

8 D. Employees eligible for the increase provided for in
9 subsection A of this section who are on leave without pay on July 1,
10 2018, shall receive an annualized increase, effective upon their
11 return to work, but shall not receive any increase for a period of
12 time prior to their return to work.

13 E. Employees who leave the state service before July 1, 2018,
14 and who are reinstated or reemployed in the state service during
15 July 2018 without a break in service, who are otherwise eligible for
16 the pay increase provided for in this section, shall be granted such
17 raise effective immediately upon such reinstatement or reemployment.
18 As used in this subsection, "break in service" is defined as a
19 period of time in excess of thirty (30) calendar days between two
20 periods of state employment.

21 F. The following officers and employees shall be ineligible for
22 a pay increase pursuant to this section and nothing, except as
23 otherwise provided by Section 840-2.17 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma

Statutes, shall be construed to authorize any increase or advancement of the salaries of:

1. Any elected official;

2. Any cabinet secretary whose salary is governed by Section 10.5 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3. Any agency director;

4. Any justice or judge whose salary is governed by the provisions of Title 85A of the Oklahoma Statutes or whose compensation is set by the Board on Judicial Compensation pursuant to Section 3.4 of Title 20 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

5. Any district attorney whose salary is governed by Section 215.30 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

6. Officers and employees of institutions under the administrative authority of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, except for officers and employees of the George Nigh Rehabilitation Institute;

7. Persons employed pursuant to Section 2241 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

8. Persons employed pursuant to Section 1.6a of Title 53 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

9. Persons who are employed or under contract pursuant to subsection B of Section 1419 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

and

1 10. The Adjutant General and Assistant Adjutants General
2 pursuant to Section 27 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

3 G. No salary increase pursuant to this section shall be made
4 that exceeds a salary limitation provided in an agency's annual
5 appropriation bill or salary limits set by statute. Classified
6 employees eligible for the salary increase provided for in this
7 section shall receive such increase even though it causes the
8 employee's salary to exceed the maximum for the employee's pay band.

9 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall be contingent upon
10 the enactment of the provisions of Enrolled House Bill No. 1010 of
11 the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature and
12 shall not become operative as law otherwise.

13 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

14 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
