By deleting all of the amendatory language beginning on Line 3 through Line 7;

Page 2, Section 1, Lines 3-10:

By striking all of the language in subsection "B" and inserting in lieu thereof, the following: "B. Such request for tentative minutes must be in writing and shall be a continuing request that is effective from the date that the minute clerk receives the request until the end of the calendar year in which the written request is made unless the request states a period of shorter duration."

Page 2, Section 1, Lines 11-13:

By deleting all of the language in subsection "C" and inserting in lieu thereof, the following: "C. Such tentative minutes shall be made available no later than the close of business on the fourth business day after each regular or special meeting, excluding the day of the meeting."

Page 2, Section 1, Line 13 ½ :

By inserting new subsections "D" and "E" to read as follows: "D. For purposes of this section, the following terms shall be defined as set forth herein:

1. "Business day" shall mean Monday through Friday and shall not include Saturday or Sunday or a legally declared Oklahoma State holiday; and
2. "Make available" shall mean in a form that may be picked up by a representative of the newspaper, radio or television station at the office of the minute clerk during regular office hours.

E. Provided however, the minute clerk shall transmit said tentative minutes to the requesting newspaper, radio or television station by email or facsimile copy if the written request of said newspaper, radio or television station contains such request."
