hours of unused accrued annual leave not to exceed two times
annually. This policy shall be optional for all eligible employees,
and the agency may choose the monthly pay period in which to provide
such payment. The employee shall retain no less than one hundred
twenty (120) hours of annual leave after such payment.

1 2. Effective November 1, 2018, the Director of the Office of
2 Management and Enterprise Services shall appoint a committee,
3 chaired by the Director or a designee, consisting of any number of
4 employees representing any state agency the Director deems
5 appropriate to study and develop a policy and rules necessary to
6 implement the program pursuant to this subsection. The committee
7 shall solicit input from state agencies and determine policies to
8 establish employee eligibility and any other relevant requirements.

9 3. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services is
10 authorized and directed to promulgate administrative rules necessary
11 to implement the provisions of this section."
