"SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-128.3 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

- A. Beginning with the 2019-2020 school year, the board of education of each school district shall spend no less than sixty percent (60%) of its annual budget on instructional expenditures.
- B. If a school district spends less than sixty percent (60%) of its annual budget on instructional expenditures, it shall increase its instructional expenditures by no less than two percent (2%) each year until the amount spent on instructional expenditures reaches sixty percent (60%) of its annual budget.
- C. If a school district spends less than sixty percent (60%) of its annual budget on instructional expenditures and does not increase its spending as provided in subsection B of this section, the school district shall receive a written warning notice from the State Department of Education. The notice shall also be posted on the website of the school district.
- D. If a school district spends less than sixty percent (60%) of its annual budget on instructional expenditures and does not increase its spending as provided in subsection B of this section for two (2) consecutive years after receiving the notice provided in subsection C of this section, the school district shall increase compensation for all teachers in the school district by two percent (2%) for each year in that period in which the school district did

1 not increase instructional expenses by a minimum of two percent 2 (2%). The pay increase required pursuant to this subsection shall 3 be permanent. 4 E. For purposes of this section, "annual budget" shall not 5 include or reflect any bonds of the school district. 6 F. As used in this section, "instructional expenditures" means 7 current expenditures for activities directly related to the interaction between teacher and students and includes salaries and 8 benefits for teachers and instructional aides, textbooks, supplies 10 and purchased instructional services such as instruction via 11 television, webinars and other online instruction.
