1       "SECTION 2.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified

2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-128.3 of Title 70, unless  
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4       A. Beginning with the 2019-2020 school year, the board of  
5 education of each school district shall spend no less than sixty  
6 percent (60%) of its annual budget on instructional expenditures.

7       B. If a school district spends less than sixty percent (60%) of  
8 its annual budget on instructional expenditures, it shall increase  
9 its instructional expenditures by no less than two percent (2%) each  
10 year until the amount spent on instructional expenditures reaches  
11 sixty percent (60%) of its annual budget.

12       C. If a school district spends less than sixty percent (60%) of  
13 its annual budget on instructional expenditures and does not  
14 increase its spending as provided in subsection B of this section,  
15 the school district shall receive a written warning notice from the  
16 State Department of Education. The notice shall also be posted on  
17 the website of the school district.

18       D. If a school district spends less than sixty percent (60%) of  
19 its annual budget on instructional expenditures and does not  
20 increase its spending as provided in subsection B of this section  
21 for two (2) consecutive years after receiving the notice provided in  
22 subsection C of this section, the school district shall increase  
23 compensation for all teachers in the school district by two percent  
24 (2%) for each year in that period in which the school district did

1 not increase instructional expenses by a minimum of two percent  
2 (2%). The pay increase required pursuant to this subsection shall  
3 be permanent.

4 E. For purposes of this section, "annual budget" shall not  
5 include or reflect any bonds of the school district.

6 F. As used in this section, "instructional expenditures" means  
7 current expenditures for activities directly related to the  
8 interaction between teacher and students and includes salaries and  
9 benefits for teachers and instructional aides, textbooks, supplies  
10 and purchased instructional services such as instruction via  
11 television, webinars and other online instruction. Also included  
12 are tuition expenditures to other schools."
