"SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10-100.27 of Title 14A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

- A. Each licensee authorized to make small loans shall pay thirty cents (\$0.30) for each loan entered into to be deposited into the Personal Financial Literacy Education Revolving Fund.
- B. The schedule for payments to the Office of the State

 Treasurer for deposit into the Personal Financial Literacy Education

 Revolving Fund shall be made by each licensee quarterly.
- C. Funds paid to the Office of the State Treasurer for deposit into the Personal Financial Literacy Education Revolving Fund pursuant to this section shall be used by the State Department of Education for the purposes provided in Section 11-103.6h of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10-100.28 of Title 14A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. In no event shall an employer be required to garnish wages, earnings or other income of an employee for the purpose of collecting debts on small loans.
- B. "Small loan" means a loan made pursuant to a written agreement subject to this act between a licensee and customer establishing a credit plan under which the licensee contemplates credit transactions from time to time that:

- May be unsecured;
- Shall not have a term longer than twelve (12) months; 2.
- Shall be fully amortized and payable in substantially equal 3. periodic payments; and
- 4. Are subject to prepayment in whole or in part at any time without penalty.
- A new section of law to be codified SECTION 4. NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.6h-1 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the State Department of Education to be designated the "Personal Financial Literacy Education Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the Department from any other public or private source. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Department for the purposes set forth in Section 11-103.6h of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment."
