1 "H. The Board shall issue a lead teaching certificate to any
2 person who upon application:

3 1. Has successfully completed the requirements of this
4 subsection;

5 2. Has a minimum of five (5) years of experience as a teacher;

6 3. Participates in a meaningful individualized program of
7 professional development, as provided for in Section 6-101.10 of
8 this title;

9 4. Has earned a "highly effective" or "superior" rating
10 pursuant to Section 6-101.16 of this title; and

11 5. May have a teaching load of not more than seventy-five
12 percent (75%) student instruction to allow the teacher to mentor
13 other teachers.

14 I. 1. The Board shall issue a master teaching certificate to
15 any person who upon application:

16 a. has successfully completed the requirements of this
17 subsection,

18 b. has a minimum of seven (7) years of experience as a
19 teacher, and

20 c. (1) has earned a "superior" rating pursuant to
21 Section 6-101.16 of this title, or

22 (2) has earned a "highly effective" rating pursuant
23 to Section 6-101.16 of this title and holds or
24 has held a National Board certification from the

National Board for Professional Teaching
Standards.

2. Teachers with a master teaching certificate may assume
leadership roles that include but are not limited to:

- a. the planning and delivery of professional development
activities designed to improve instructional
strategies,
- b. the facilitation of an instructional leadership team
within the building or school district in which the
lead teacher is assigned, and
- c. the mentoring of other teachers and participation in
evaluations of other teachers.

3. Teachers with a master teaching certificate may have a
teaching load of not more than fifty percent (50%) student
instruction to allow the lead teacher to spend time on:

- a. co-teaching,
- b. co-planning,
- c. peer reviews, and
- d. other duties mutually agreed upon by the
superintendent and the master teacher, and may be used
to satisfy the qualitative evaluation component for
teachers as required by Section 6-101.16 of this title
by performing the duties set forth in this paragraph.

1 J. The State Board of Education shall adopt rules to implement
2 a renewal schedule and associated fees for lead and master teaching
3 certificates. The rules shall allow a teacher that no longer meets
4 the requirements of a lead or master teaching certificate to make
5 application for the standard teaching certificate.

6 K. The terms of the contracts issued to those holding lead and
7 master teaching certificates shall include the following:

8 1. Lead: an additional ten (10) days to be used to strengthen
9 instructional leadership. A person with a lead teaching certificate
10 shall receive an annual salary supplement of at least Three Thousand
11 Dollars (\$3,000.00) or the district's daily rate of pay, whichever
12 is higher, in addition to the salary for which the teacher qualifies
13 pursuant to Section 18-114.14 of this title; and

14 2. Master: an additional fifteen (15) days to be used to
15 strengthen leadership. A person with a master teaching certificate
16 shall receive an annual salary supplement of at least Five Thousand
17 Dollars (\$5,000.00) or the district's daily rate of pay, whichever
18 is higher, in addition to the salary for which the teacher qualifies
19 pursuant to Section 18-114.14 of this title.

20 If a person with a lead or master teaching certificate changes
21 school districts during the life of the certificate, the terms of
22 the contracts required in this subsection shall be subject to
23 approval by the new employing school district.

1 L. 1. Any person who is eligible for a lead or master teaching
2 certificate described in this section shall make application for the
3 following school year with the State Board of Education. The
4 application shall include a recommendation from the local board of
5 education and determination that the applicant has met the statutory
6 criteria. In reviewing an application, the local school board of
7 education and the superintendent shall consider the ability of the
8 school district to fulfill the additional requirements described in
9 subsections H and I of this section before making a recommendation
10 to the State Board of Education.

11 2. The State Department of Education shall develop an
12 application to implement the provisions of this subsection and make
13 it available to school districts.

14 M. Beginning in the 2021-2022 school year, the Department shall
15 make the teaching certificates provided for in this section
16 available for any person who has received a recommendation from
17 their local board of education and who meets the eligibility
18 criteria.

19 N. For the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 school years, the Department
20 shall identify school districts to implement the teaching
21 certificates provided for in this section on a pilot program basis
22 with the assistance of public-private partnerships, funding from
23 philanthropic organizations or federal grants.

1 O. The Department shall seek funding necessary for the
2 administration of this section. If funding for the administration
3 of the teaching certificates listed in paragraphs H and I is not
4 available, the Department shall not be required to fulfill the
5 requirements listed in subsections K, L, M and N of the section.

6 P. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to
7 implement the provisions of this act.

8 SECTION 2. REPEALER Sections 1, 2 and 3, Chapter 275,
9 O.S.L. 2016 (70 O.S. Supp. 2017, Sections 6-301, 6-302 and 6-303),
10 are hereby repealed."
