 - 7. The Secretary of Energy and Environment of the State of Oklahoma, who shall serve as Chair of the Review Committee.
 - C. A study shall be performed to determine if the Oklahoma

 Corporation Commission is properly structured to efficiently operate

 in the twenty-first century. Such study shall include but not be

 limited to an assessment of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission

 related to the following issues:
 - 1. A performance assessment, addressing:
 - a. current workload levels,
 - b. time required to process workload and individual cases; and
 - 2. A structural assessment, addressing:
 - a. the makeup of the Commission and the impact of the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act requirements,

- assessment of the issues listed in subsection C of this section, the Review Committee may seek input from stakeholders, including the various businesses regulated by the Corporation Commission, such as representatives from the oil and gas, telecommunications, transportation, electric utilities, natural gas pipeline, natural gas local distribution companies and others involved in processes at the Corporation Commission including consumer groups, individual citizens, industrial associations, corporation commission staff and all others that would like to participate.
 - E. The Review Committee may conduct business without a quorum of its membership being present, but a quorum shall be required to be present for purposes of adoption of the final report of the Review Committee.

- F. The Review Committee may request the assistance of any state agency, board, commission, department or other entity of state government to acquire relevant information for purposes of the study.
- G. The Review Committee shall develop a final report with specific recommendations and transmit the report not later than September 1, 2018, to the Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate.
- H. Each member of the Review Committee shall serve without compensation.
