13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 185, O.S.L.
15	2012 (74 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 840-2.10a), is amended to read as
16	follows:
17	Section 840-2.10a. A. The following state State agencies shall
18	provide or contract to provide, through the State Employee
19	Assistance Program, debriefing and counseling services for state
20	employees who are affected by violent or involved in, witness or are
21	otherwise exposed to traumatic events that occur in the workplace:
22	1. The Department of Human Services;
23	2. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse

1 3. The Department of Corrections;

4. The Department of Transportation; and

- 5. The Office of Juvenile Affairs.
- B. State employees who are affected by violent or such
 traumatic events that occur in the workplace events shall be
 encouraged to participate in debriefing or counseling services, and
 paid administrative leave shall be provided for attendance at such
 debriefings and counseling sessions; however, employees shall have
 the option to refuse the debriefing and counseling services offered
 pursuant to subsection A of this section.
 - C. The Director of the Office of State Finance Management and Enterprise Services shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section which, at a minimum, shall specify provide the types of events which shall procedure to qualify state employees for debriefing and counseling services.
 - D. For purposes of this section, "traumatic events" shall mean an event that results in severe bodily injury, maiming, death, natural disaster, catastrophic event resulting in significant property damage or exposure to a person brandishing a firearm or other deadly weapon that is not part of a person's work duties or scope of employment.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
