BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.7j of Title 74, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Beginning January 1, 2018, the Roof Asset Management
Program, also known as the RAMP program, or a successor program
authorized by statute or agency rule, shall be known as the Oklahoma
Optional Roofing Program. Whenever the terms "Roof Asset Management
Program" or "RAMP", when used to reference the "Oklahoma Optional
Roofing Program", appear in statute or rule, such terms shall mean
the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program.

1 B. 1. Upon the effective date of this act, except for those
2 contracts entered into before the effective date of this act, any
3 contract for roofing repairs or replacement entered into on behalf
4 of a state agency or political subdivision by the Office of
5 Management and Enterprise Services utilizing an ongoing contracting
6 program through the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program, or a
7 successor program authorized by statute or agency rule, that does
8 not exceed a total of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be
9 required to utilize the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program.

10 2. Upon the effective date of this act, except for those
11 contracts entered into before the effective date of this act, any
12 contract for roofing repairs or replacement entered into on behalf
13 of a state agency or political subdivision by the Office of
14 Management and Enterprise Services utilizing an ongoing contracting
15 program through the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program, or a
16 successor program authorized by statute or agency rule, that exceeds
17 a total of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) may utilize the
18 Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program or may adhere to the requirements
19 of the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974.

20 3. Upon the effective date of this act, except for those
21 contracts entered into before the effective date of this act, the
22 Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall collect a fee for
23 services provided by the Office under the Oklahoma Optional Roofing
24 Program, or a successor program authorized by statute or agency

1 rule, of no more than one percent (1%) of the roofing contract
2 price.

3 4. Upon the effective date of this act, except for those
4 contracts entered into before the effective date of this act, the
5 Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall permit no more
6 than six contractors, but no less than four contractors in the same
7 region of the state to enter into contracts for roofing repairs or
8 replacement through the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program
9 simultaneously.

10 ~~SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation~~
11 ~~of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby~~
12 ~~declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and~~
13 ~~be in full force from and after its passage and approval.~~
