B. 1. Upon the effective date of this act, except for those contracts entered into before the effective date of this act, any contract for roofing repairs or replacement entered into on behalf of a state agency or political subdivision by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services utilizing an ongoing contracting program through the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program, or a successor program authorized by statute or agency rule, that does not exceed a total of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be required to utilize the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program.

- 2. Upon the effective date of this act, except for those contracts entered into before the effective date of this act, any contract for roofing repairs or replacement entered into on behalf of a state agency or political subdivision by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services utilizing an ongoing contracting program through the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program, or a successor program authorized by statute or agency rule, that exceeds a total of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) may utilize the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program or may adhere to the requirements of the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974.
- 3. Upon the effective date of this act, except for those contracts entered into before the effective date of this act, the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall collect a fee for services provided by the Office under the Oklahoma Optional Roofing Program, or a successor program authorized by statute or agency
