11 Act of 1967 - Director of the Department of  
12 Corrections - implementation of pilot program -  
13 contracts - effective date ]

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2011, Section 507, is  
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 507. The Director shall be the executive officer of the  
18 Department of Corrections and shall have the following general  
19 powers and duties:

20 (a) To supervise the activities of the Department and, subject  
21 to the policies established by the Board, to act for the Department  
22 in all matters, except as may be otherwise provided in ~~this act~~ the  
23 Oklahoma Corrections Act of 1967.

1 (b) To prescribe rules and regulations for the operation of the  
2 Department, consistent with the general policies established by the  
3 Board.

4 (c) To appoint and fix the duties and salaries of such  
5 personnel for the Department as may be necessary to administer and  
6 carry out the provisions of ~~this act~~ the Oklahoma Corrections Act of  
7 1967. The Department and the employees thereof, except the members  
8 of the Board and the Director shall be subject to the provisions of  
9 the State Merit System of Personnel Administration, but the Governor  
10 may by Executive Order exempt positions therefrom as authorized by  
11 Section 802 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, except as may be  
12 otherwise provided in ~~this act~~ the Oklahoma Corrections Act of 1967.

13 (d) To accept, use, disburse and administer grants, allotments,  
14 gifts, devises, bequests, appropriations and other monies and  
15 property offered or given to the Department, or any component or  
16 agency thereof, by any agency of the federal government or any  
17 corporation or individual for the use of the Department.

18 (e) 1. To investigate the possible inclusion in a federally-  
19 funded pilot program sponsored by the Federal Communications  
20 Commission relating to the use of cellular and electronic  
21 communication devices within the statewide network of prisons in  
22 Oklahoma.

23 2. In the event that the Federal Communications Commission  
24 amends the regulations relating to the use of cellular and

1 electronic communication devices within prisons, the Director is  
2 authorized to initiate a pilot program regarding the use of  
3 available technology to prohibit the use of cellular and electronic  
4 communication devices by incarcerated offenders within the statewide  
5 network of prisons in Oklahoma.

6 3. Absent regulations of the Federal Communications Commission  
7 prohibiting the use of such technology, the Director is authorized  
8 to use available technology to prohibit the use of cellular and  
9 electronic communication devices by incarcerated offenders within  
10 the statewide network of prisons in Oklahoma using federal or state  
11 funds.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
