13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 208.11a of Title 3A, unless
16	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. On and after the November 1, 2018, any rule or change in
18	rule made by the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission related to equine
19	medications and drugs or drug testing of a horse prior to or during
20	a race including, but not limited to, threshold levels for
21	therapeutic medications and drugs shall require such rule to be
22	reviewed by the Medication Advisory Committee with a requirement
23	that the Committee recommendations shall be presented to the

Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission during a public meeting of the
 Commission prior to adoption.

B. There is hereby created the Medication Advisory Committee
under the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission. The Medication Advisory
Committee shall be appointed annually by the Oklahoma Horse Racing
Commission. The Committee shall be composed of thirteen (13)
members and shall include all of the following:

8 1. Four members of the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission, or9 their designee;

The State Veterinarian employed or contracted by the
 Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission;

12 3. One member of the Board of Stewards employed or contracted13 by the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission, or designee;

14 4. Two members who shall each be a representative from each of15 the recognized horsemen's representative organizations;

16 5. Three members who shall each be a representative from the 17 currently licensed horsemen's organizations;

Two practicing veterinarians with one to be identified by
 the thoroughbred horsemen's representative organization and one to
 be identified by the representative of all non-thoroughbred breeds.

C. The Medication Advisory Committee shall be chaired by a
member of the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission as designated by the
Chair of the Commission. The Medication Advisory Committee shall
serve in an advisory capacity only and any members of the Committee,

1 other than the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission members, shall not 2 be entitled to either compensation or reimbursement for travel or 3 expenses.

D. Members of the Medication Advisory Committee shall be exempt from the dual-office holding provision of Section 6 of Title 51 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

7 E. For purposes of conducting business, seven members shall constitute a quorum. Any vacancy occurring in memberships shall by 8 9 filled in the same manner as an initial appointment for the 10 unexpired term. Initial appointment shall be made by the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission by November 1, 2018, and annually 11 thereafter.
