13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 150.9.1 of Title 74, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The Oklahoma Tax Commission, Oklahoma Department of Human
18 Services and Oklahoma Employment Security Commission shall be
19 authorized to require agency employees in positions that have access
20 to Federal Tax Information and data to supply all information and
21 documentation required in order to be subjected to a criminal
22 history search by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, as
23 well as be fingerprinted for submission of the fingerprints through
24 the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to the Federal Bureau of

1 Investigation for a national criminal history check. The applicable
2 employer-agency shall be the recipient of the results of the record
3 check. In accordance with Section 150.9 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
4 Statutes, this includes a national criminal record with a
5 fingerprint analysis.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
