14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified			
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.7j of Title 74, unless there			
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:			
17	A. Upon the effective date of this act, the Office of			
18	Management and Enterprise Services shall be required to combine the			
19	following non-mandatory construction and property services provided

22	2. The On-Call Consultants Program;

B. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall collect a fee for services provided by the Office under the Roof Asset Management Program (RAMP), or a successor program authorized by statute or agency, of no more than one percent (1%) of the roofing contract price.
```

C. Any contract for roofing repairs or replacement entered into on behalf of a state agency or political subdivision by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services utilizing an ongoing contracting program through the Roofing Asset Management Program (RAMP) or a successor program authorized by state or agency rule, shall not exceed a total of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00).

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
