14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:			
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified			
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 18.1 of Title 76, unless there			
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:			
18	A. As used in this section:			
19	1. "Continuous treatment" shall not include examinations			
20	undertaken at the request of the patient for the sole purpose of			
21	ascertaining the state of the patient's condition;			
22	2. "Health care provider" means any physician or hospital			
23	licensed by this state to provide health care services or an			
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officer, employee or agent thereof acting in the course and scope of employment; and
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- 3. "Health care services" means acts of diagnosis, treatment, medical evaluation or advice or such other acts as may be permissible under the health care licensing statutes of this state.
- B. An action based on tort, breach of contract or otherwise, for damages for injury against a health care provider for alleged professional negligence, for the performance of health care services without consent, or for error or omission in the practice of the health care provider's profession, which occurs on or after the effective date of this act, shall be commenced within ten (10) years of the act, omission or failure complained of or of the last treatment where there was continuous treatment for the same illness, injury or condition which gave rise to the act, omission or failure.

 SECTION 2. REPEALER 76 O.S. 2011, Section 18, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
