FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to judicial districts; amending 20 O.S. 2011, Sections 92.6 and 92.7, which relate to District No. 5 and District No. 6; modifying composition of judges in certain districts after specified date; updating language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 20 O.S. 2011, Section 92.6, is amended to read as follows:

Section 92.6. District No. 5. ~~The~~ A. For elections occurring before January 1, 2022, the counties of Comanche, Stephens, Cotton and Jefferson. ~~Said~~ The district shall have five (5) district judges to be nominated as follows: Candidates for office Nos. 1 and 4 to be nominated and elected at large and legal residents of Comanche or Cotton County; a candidate for office No. 2 to be nominated and elected at large and a legal resident of Stephens or

1 Jefferson County; and candidates for office Nos. 3 and 5 to be
2 nominated and elected at large and legal residents of Comanche
3 County.

4 B. For elections occurring on or after January 1, 2022, the
5 counties of Comanche and Cotton. The district shall have four (4)
6 district judges to be nominated as follows: Candidates for office
7 Nos. 1 and 4 to be nominated and elected at large and legal
8 residents of Comanche or Cotton County; and candidates for office
9 Nos. 2 and 3 to be nominated and elected at large and legal
10 residents of Comanche County.

11 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 20 O.S. 2011, Section 92.7, is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Section 92.7. District No. 6. ~~The~~ A. For elections occurring
14 before January 1, 2022, the counties of Grady and Caddo. ~~Said~~ The
15 district shall have one district judge to be nominated and elected
16 at large.

17 B. For elections occurring on or after January 1, 2022, the
18 counties of Grady, Stephens, Jefferson and Caddo. The district
19 shall have two (2) district judges to be nominated as follows: A
20 candidate for office No. 1 to be nominated and elected at large and
21 a legal resident of Grady or Caddo County; and a candidate for
22 office No. 2 to be nominated and elected at large and a legal
23 resident of Stephens or Jefferson County.
