[child care - nutrition standards - codification -
effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 405.5 of Title 10, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

All licensed child care centers shall:

1. Follow the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP)
nutrition standards for infants;
2. Provide children with opportunities for moderate and
vigorous physical activity for at least sixty (60) cumulative
minutes per day during a full-day program, including daily outdoor
physical activity when possible, and by providing infants daily
opportunities to freely explore their indoor and outdoor

1 environments under adult supervision, including engaging with
2 infants on the ground each day to optimize adult-infant interactions
3 and providing daily time in the prone position for infants less than
4 six (6) months of age; and

5 3. Eliminate screen time, including television, movies,
6 cellular phones, video games, computers and other digital devices
7 for children less than two (2) years of age. The provisions of this
8 paragraph shall not apply to:

- 9 a. electronic media involving physical activity
10 participation,
11 b. electronic media when used for children's homework,
12 c. e-readers when used for reading,
13 d. smart boards and tables when used for hands-on
14 learning activities, such as drawing or puzzles,
15 e. occasional special activities, such as watching a
16 movie, and
17 f. assistive or adaptive technology for children with
18 disabilities.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
