- 3. Eliminate screen time, including television, movies, cellular phones, video games, computers and other digital devices for children less than two (2) years of age. The provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to:
 - a. electronic media involving physical activity participation,
 - b. electronic media when used for children's homework,
 - c. e-readers when used for reading,
 - d. smart boards and tables when used for hands-on learning activities, such as drawing or puzzles,
 - e. occasional special activities, such as watching a movie, and
 - f. assistive or adaptive technology for children with disabilities.
- 19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
