11                               COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12                   An Act relating to teacher pay; providing definition;  
13                   making allocation for certain salary increase for  
14                   certain teachers; specifying amount of salary  
15                   increase; providing for proration of funds for  
16                   certain teachers; prohibiting certain use of funds;  
17                   providing for disbursement of funds; providing for  
18                   codification; and providing for contingent effect  
19                   based on prior enactment of Enrolled House Bill No.  
20                   1035 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 56th  
21                   Oklahoma Legislature.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21                   SECTION 1.           NEW LAW           A new section of law to be codified  
22                   in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 18-114.15 of Title 70, unless  
23                   there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1       A. For purposes of this section, "certified classroom teacher"  
2 means any certified, full-time employee who is employed as a charter  
3 school teacher, district-wide teacher, elementary teacher, junior  
4 high teacher, middle school teacher, senior high teacher or resource  
5 teacher.

6       B. Beginning August 1, 2018, funding for certified classroom  
7 teacher salary increases shall be allocated to local public school  
8 districts in the amount of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) per  
9 certified classroom teacher, as defined in this section. For  
10 certified classroom teachers whose salary is funded partially by  
11 federal funds, the salary increase provided for in this section  
12 shall be prorated according to the percentage of the salary that is  
13 state funded. No part of the amount of Three Thousand Dollars  
14 (\$3,000.00) provided for each certified classroom teacher shall be  
15 used by school districts to fund the employer contribution payments  
16 mandated by Section 17-108.1 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes  
17 and the employer Federal Insurance Contributions Act (F.I.C.A.)  
18 payments attributable to the salary increase.

19       C. Beginning August 1, 2018, the salary level of each state  
20 paid certified classroom teacher shall be increased by at least  
21 Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00), unless the hours or the duties  
22 of the teacher are reduced proportionately. The salary increase  
23 provided for in this section shall be in addition to, and not as a  
24 replacement for, the step increase indicated for the certified

1 classroom teacher pursuant to the State Minimum Salary Schedule, as  
2 provided for in Section 18-114.14 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma  
3 Statutes, and shall not be contingent upon school district adoption  
4 of or participation in a merit-based or incentive pay plan for  
5 certified classroom teachers. The State Department of Education  
6 shall disburse these monies to local school districts on a monthly  
7 basis through the State Aid Formula beginning August 1, 2018. To  
8 determine the amount of the initial disbursements for each school  
9 district, the State Board of Education shall use the data of the  
10 number of certified classroom teachers as reported in the final  
11 Oklahoma Annual Certified Personnel Report for FY2018.

12 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall be contingent upon  
13 the enactment of the provisions of Enrolled House Bill No. 1035 of  
14 the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature and  
15 shall not become operative as law otherwise.
