9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to schools; prohibiting Legislature
11 from enacting certain mandates on public school
12 districts unless funding is provided; and providing
 an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-129.12 of Title 70, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The Legislature shall be prohibited, after the effective date of
20 this act, from enacting measures that create new mandates or amend
21 an existing mandate in a way that increases costs on public school
22 districts unless sufficient funding is appropriated by the
23 Legislature or another source of funding is otherwise provided for
24 to pay the cost of the mandate.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
