| 15 | SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 12-602, is |
| 16 | amended to read as follows: |
| 17 | Section 12-602. A. Every motorcycle shall be equipped with at |
| 18 | least one headlamp emitting a white light which shall comply with |
| 19 | the applicable requirements and limitations of Section 12-203 of |
| 20 | this title and of Sections 12-224, 12-225 <u>12-203.4</u> , 12-227 and , 12- |
| 21 | 228 <u>and 12-602.1</u> of this title. |
| 22 | B. Every headlamp upon every motorcycle shall be located at a |
| 23 | height of not more than fifty-four (54) inches nor less than twenty- |
| 24 | |

- 1 two (22) inches to be measured as set forth in subsection B of 2 Section 12-202 of this title.
- C. Subject to subsections A and B of this section, a motorcycle

 may be equipped with, and an operator of a motorcycle may use, as

 auxiliary lighting, light-emitting diode pods and strips; provided

 the color of such lighting shall be limited to white on the front of

 the motorcycle, amber on the sides of the motorcycle and red on the

 rear of the motorcycle.
- 9 <u>D. Lighting authorized pursuant to subsection C of this section</u>
 10 shall be:
- 11 1. Nonblinking;
 - Nonflashing;
- 3. Nonoscillating; and
- 14 <u>4. Directed toward the engine and the drive train of the</u>
 15 motorcycle to prevent interference with the driver's operation of
 16 the vehicle.
- 17 E. For purposes of this section:
 - 1. "Headlamp" shall not include passing lamp; and
- 2. "Passing lamp" shall mean an auxiliary front low-beam lamp which emits a white light.
- 21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
