11 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
12 2011, Section 1135.5, as last amended by Section 25,
13 Chapter 210, O.S.L. 2016 (47 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section
14 1135.5), which relates to demonstration of support
15 and financial assistance special license plates;
16 creating the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission License
17 Plate; establishing plates as financial assistance
18 license plates; providing for design of license
19 plates; requiring certain portion of fees be
20 deposited in certain fund; amending 3 O.S. 2011,
21 Section 91, as amended by Section 21, Chapter 304,
22 O.S.L. 2012 (3 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 91), which
23 relates to the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission
24 Revolving Fund; authorizing deposit of certain fees;
 authorizing expenditure of funds for certain purpose;
 and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
2 last amended by Section 25, Chapter 210, O.S.L. 2016 (47 O.S. Supp.
3 2016, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
5 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
6 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
7 financial assistance as provided by this section.

8 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
9 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
10 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
11 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
12 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

13 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
14 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
15 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
16 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
17 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
18 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
19 issued on a staggered system.

20 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
21 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
22 applications for special license plates authorized under this
23 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
24 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount

1 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
2 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
3 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
4 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
5 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
6 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
7 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

8 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
9 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
10 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
11 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
12 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
13 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
14 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
15 removed from the vehicle.

16 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
17 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
18 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
19 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
20 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
21 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
22 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
23 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
24 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

1 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
2 follows:

3 1. University or College Supporter License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
5 demonstrate support to any state-supported or private university or
6 college. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
7 collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this
8 title;

9 2. Environmental Awareness License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
10 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the
11 Tax Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
12 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
13 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
14 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
15 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
16 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
17 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
18 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
19 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
20 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
21 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
22 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
23 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
24 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

1 3. Firefighter License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
3 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
4 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
5 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
6 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
7 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
8 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
9 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
10 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
11 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
12 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
13 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
14 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
15 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
16 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

17 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
18 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
19 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
20 the Oklahoma ~~Firefighter~~ Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

21 4. Wildlife Conservation License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
22 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the
23 Tax Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation
24 in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any

1 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
2 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
3 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
4 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
5 plates.

6 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
7 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
8 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

9 5. Child Abuse Prevention License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
10 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the
11 Tax Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
12 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
13 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
14 the prevention of child abuse.

15 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
16 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

17 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License ~~Plates~~
18 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person
19 wishing to demonstrate support for the United States Olympic
20 Committee. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
21 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
22 as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the
23 official United States Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission
24 shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a licensing

1 agreement with the United States Olympic Committee for any licensing
2 fees which may be required in order to use the United States Olympic
3 Committee logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for
4 a payment of not more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each
5 license plate issued;

6 7. Oklahoma History License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
8 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
9 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
10 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

11 8. Historic Route 66 License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall
12 be designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
13 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
14 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
15 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
16 Oklahoma;

17 9. Heart of the Heartland License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the
19 victims of the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah
20 Federal Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As
21 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
22 deposited in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as
23 established in Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 10. Emergency Medical Technician License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any person who is an
3 emergency medical technician. Such persons may apply for an
4 emergency medical technician license plate for each vehicle with a
5 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
6 emergency medical technician's license. The license plate shall be
7 designed in consultation with the state association of emergency
8 medical technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the
9 fee collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical
10 ~~Technician~~ Personnel Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section
11 1-2505.2 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

12 11. Fight Breast Cancer License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
13 shall be designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and
14 treatment of breast cancer in this state. As provided in this
15 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the
16 Breast Cancer Act Revolving Fund;

17 12. Crime Victims Awareness License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
19 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
20 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
21 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
22 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
23 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
24

1 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
2 provide services to crime victims;

3 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
5 demonstrate support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids
6 Association. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
7 with the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. As provided in this
8 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
9 Children's Hospital - Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund
10 to be distributed to the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

11 14. Four-H Club License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
13 by the Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to
14 demonstrate support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed
15 and issued to any person as for personalized license plates. As
16 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
17 apportioned to the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving
18 Fund created in Section 1104.4 of this title;

19 15. Agricultural Awareness License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
20 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
21 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
22 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
23 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag
24 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an

1 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
2 Section 1104.3 of this title;

3 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
5 commemorate the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in
6 1907. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
7 Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission.
8 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
9 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
10 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
11 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

12 17. Support Education License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall
13 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
14 Commission by the State Department of Education in consultation with
15 the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
16 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
17 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
18 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
19 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
20 follows:

- 21 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
22 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 23 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
24 Education Revolving Fund,

- 1 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
2 Career Technology Fund, and
- 3 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
4 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
5 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
6 Oklahoma Statutes.

7 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
8 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
9 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
10 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
11 paragraph;

12 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License ~~Plates~~
13 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired
14 officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall
15 have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the
16 plate, the Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and
17 pattern as used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license
18 plate shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used
19 in combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
20 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.

21 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
22 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
23 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
24 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the

1 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
2 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
3 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
4 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
5 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

6 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
7 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
8 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
9 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
10 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
11 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.
12 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
13 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
14 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts
15 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
16 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
17 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

18 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License ~~Plates~~ Plate -
19 such plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented
20 to the Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture,
21 Food, and Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in
22 this state that develop and operate programs to encourage urban
23 forestry and beautification, and issued to any person wishing to
24 demonstrate support of such programs. As provided in this section,

1 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
2 Section 1104.5 of this title;

3 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
5 Tax Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department,
6 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
7 Oklahoma state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the
8 fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and
9 Recreation Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be
10 designated for and may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma
11 state parks;

12 22. Adoption Creates Families License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
13 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
14 of pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
15 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive
16 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and
17 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates
18 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
19 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human
20 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall
21 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury
22 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the
23 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act
24 specifically for created families;

1 23. Choose Life License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by
3 Choose Life, Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to
4 demonstrate support of organizations that encourage adoption as a
5 positive choice for women with unplanned pregnancies. As provided
6 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
7 in the Choose Life Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in
8 Section 1104.6 of this title;

9 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
10 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
11 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
12 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
13 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
14 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
15 Section 1104.7 of this title;

16 25. Lions Club License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
18 the Lions Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any
19 person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
20 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license
21 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions
22 Service Foundation and shall contain the official logo of the
23 International Association of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall
24 be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma

1 Lions Service Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for
2 a payment to the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than
3 Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

4 26. Color Oklahoma License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be
5 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
6 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
7 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
8 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
9 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
10 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
11 Section 1104.8 of this title;

12 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
13 License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to
14 any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
15 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
16 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
17 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
18 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
19 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
20 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
21 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
22 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
23 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
24 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout

1 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
2 plate issued;

3 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
5 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The
6 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City
7 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
8 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon
9 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
10 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing
11 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial
12 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
13 plate issued;

14 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
16 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
17 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
18 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

19 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
20 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
21 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
22 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
23 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
24 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty

1 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
2 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

3 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
5 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
6 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
7 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
8 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
9 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
10 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
11 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
12 Section 1104.10 of this title;

13 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
14 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
15 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who
16 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active
17 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
18 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
19 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
20 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
21 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

22 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
23 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
24 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma

1 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
2 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on
3 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
4 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
5 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
6 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
7 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

8 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License ~~Plates~~
9 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person
10 wishing to demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of
11 America. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
12 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
13 as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the
14 official Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission,
15 if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with the Boys and
16 Girls Clubs of America for any licensing fees which may be required
17 in order to use the Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design.
18 The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and
19 Girls Clubs of America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
20 each license plate issued;

21 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates
22 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
23 support for the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall
24 be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse

1 Association. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee
2 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving
3 Fund created in Section 1104.12 of this title;

4 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
5 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
6 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
7 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates
8 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
9 letters from one to maximum of seven, as for personalized license
10 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected

18 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Alzheimer's Research
19 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.20 of this

22 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
23 for the Oklahoma Hospice and Palliative Care Association. The
24 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma

2 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
3 Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate Revolving Fund created in

17 as space permits or a new design in order to meet the space
18 requirements of a motorcycle license plate. The Tax Commission
19 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the
20 Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police for any licensing fees
21 which may be required in order to use the association's logo or
22 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
23 Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police of not more than Twenty
24 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued. Subject to the

provisions of subsection A of this section, the Chiefs of Police License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015;

54. Crossings Christian School License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Crossings Christian School located in Oklahoma City. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the administration of Crossings Christian School. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with Crossings Christian School for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the school's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Crossings Christian School of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

55. Hilldale Education Foundation License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Hilldale Education Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the administration of the Hilldale Education Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Hilldale Education Foundation for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Hilldale Education Foundation of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

15 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
16 for Concerns of Police Survivors, Inc. Such plates shall be
17 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma chapter of Concerns of
18 Police Survivors, Inc. As provided in this section, an amount of
19 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Concerns of
20 Police Survivors License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section
21 1104.27 of this title; and

22 61. Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission License Plate - such plates
23 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
24 support for the Oklahoma aviation industry and to promote awareness

1 of aviation and aerospace. Such plates shall be designed in
2 consultation with the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission and shall be
3 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
4 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. Twenty-four
5 Dollars (\$24.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
6 Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission Revolving Fund, for expenditure as
7 provided in Section 91 of Title 3 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

8 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
9 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
10 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
11 fee shall be apportioned as follows:

12 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) or any other amount as provided in
13 this title of the fee shall be apportioned as provided or deposited
14 in a fund as specified within the paragraph authorizing the special
15 license plate;

16 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the

22 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 3 O.S. 2011, Section 91, as
23 amended by Section 21, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (3 O.S. Supp. 2016,
24 Section 91), is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 91. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
2 revolving fund for the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission to be
3 designated as the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission Revolving Fund.
4 The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year
5 limitations, and shall consist of a monthly allocation by the
6 Oklahoma Tax Commission of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) from
7 the motor fuel excise tax levied and collected pursuant to the
8 provisions of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes, such amount being a
9 part of the estimated amount of tax paid on gasoline consumed by
10 engines to propel aircraft in Oklahoma, sale of surplus property,
11 fees and receipts collected pursuant to the Oklahoma Open Records
12 Act, donations, gifts, bequests, contribution, devices, interagency
13 reimbursements, federal funds unless otherwise provided by federal
14 law or regulation, sale of leases and aircraft registration fees and
15 taxes, fees authorized by Section 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma
16 Statutes or any other source. All monies accruing to ~~said~~ the fund
17 are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the
18 Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission for airport construction and
19 rehabilitation programs ~~and~~, general operations of the agency, for
20 promoting the awareness of aviation and aerospace, and providing
21 financial support for aviation education programs to address the
22 need for a skilled and competent aviation workforce. Expenditures
23 from ~~said~~ the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State
24 Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the

1 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
2 approval and payment.

3 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
