10 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
11 2011, Section 1140.1, which relates to cameras for
12 certain motor license agents; expanding eligibility
 for camera to be furnished; and providing an
 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1140.1, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 1140.1 A. Any motor license agent appointed on or
19 after July 1, 2002, within a specific municipality shall be
20 furnished a camera by the Department of Public Safety without charge
21 if, ~~based:~~

22 1. Based upon the number of driver licenses issued during the
23 preceding year, the total number of licenses issued shall average
24 not less than one thousand two hundred (1,200) per year per camera

1 within the municipality and not less than one thousand two hundred
2 (1,200) per year per camera within the county; ~~provided, or~~

3 2. The motor license agent is located in a municipality with a
4 population greater than five hundred (500) and the municipality is
5 located fifteen (15) miles or more from any other motor license
6 agency.

7 B. In addition to the provisions of subsection A of this
8 section, each county shall have at least one motor license agent who
9 shall be furnished a camera.

10 ~~B.~~ C. For the purposes of this section, each motor license
11 agent appointed after July 1, 2002, shall be considered a new agent,
12 whether assets of another agency were inherited, purchased or
13 otherwise acquired.

14 ~~C.~~ D. The furnishing of any camera shall be subject to
15 availability from the vendor and, if limited, shall be allocated
16 according to this section.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
