11 An Act relating to schools; permitting school
12 districts to offer certain remediation course;
13 providing for certain construction; providing for
14 codification; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-107.1 of Title 70, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. Each school district in this state may offer a remediation
21 course for high school students who score below a nineteen (19) on
22 the American College Testing (ACT) exam or below an equivalent score
23 on the SAT exam.

1 B. Nothing in subsection A of this section shall be construed
2 to require that a teacher providing instruction in the remediation
3 course be certified in any subject matter that is tested on the ACT
4 or SAT exam.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
