No school district shall prohibit or take disciplinary 21 action against teachers for: 22 1. Disclosing public information to correct what the teacher 23 reasonably believes evidences a violation of the Oklahoma

Constitution or law or a rule promulgated pursuant to law;

2	or federal law, rule or policy; mismanagement; a gross waste of
3	public funds; an abuse of authority; or a substantial and specific
4	danger to public health or safety; or
5	3. Taking any of the above actions without giving prior notice
6	to the teacher's supervisor or anyone else in the teacher's chain
7	of command.
8	C. Each school district shall prominently post or publish a
9	copy of this section of law in locations where it can reasonably be
10	expected to come to the attention of all teachers.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
